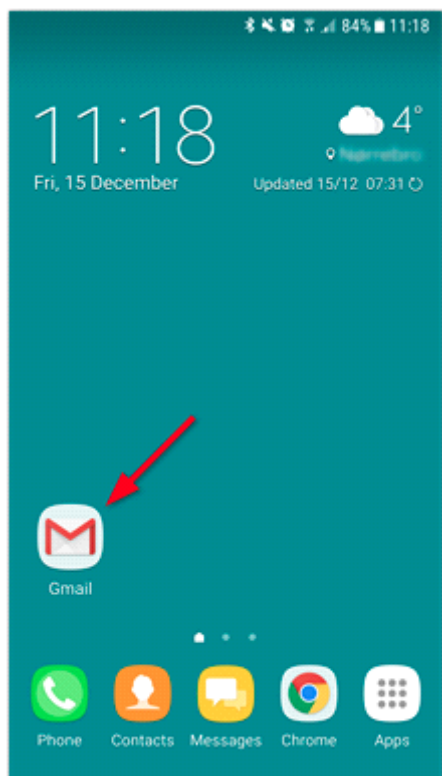


Manual for configuring account Android.

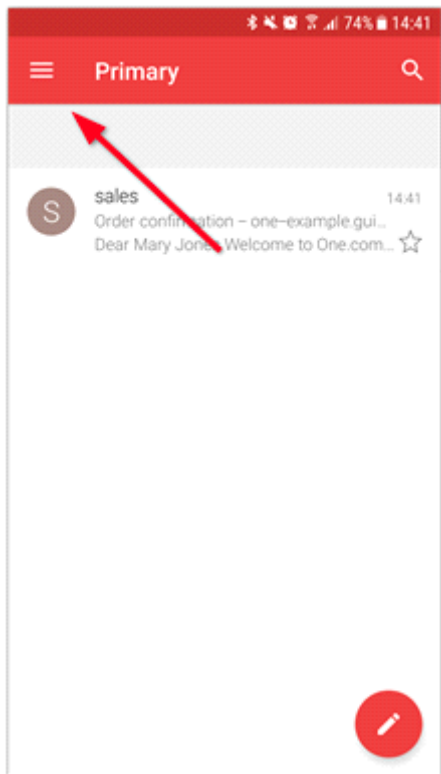
Step 1 - Open the Gmail app

Open the Gmail app on your Android device.



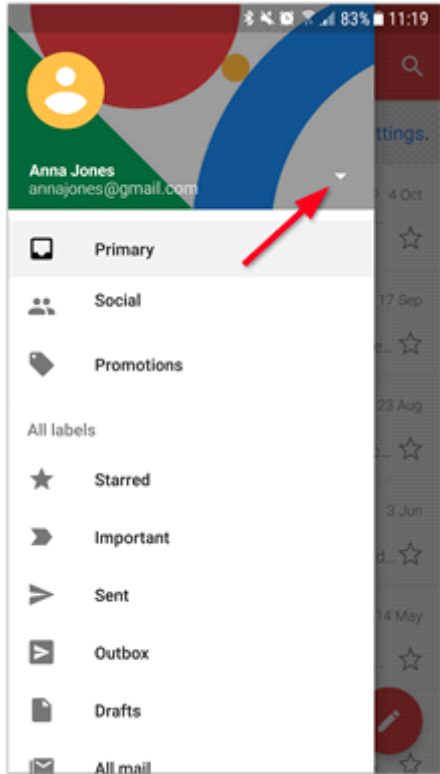
Step 2 - Go to Settings

Click the menu in the top left corner to open Settings.



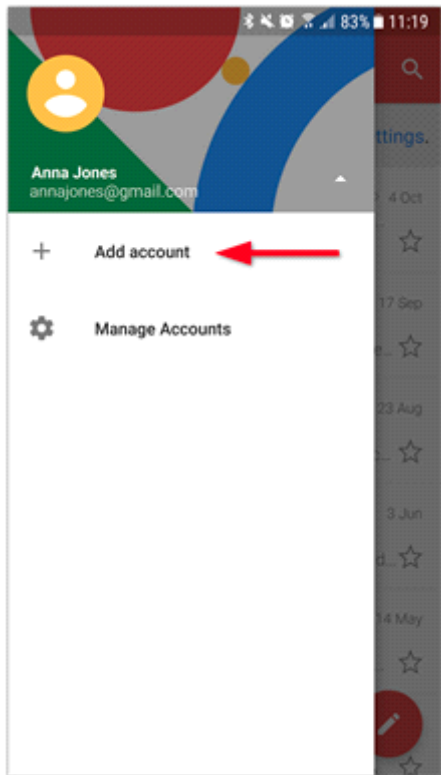
Step 3 - Click the arrow right of your email

At the top of your screen, click the small arrow next to your name and email address to open **Accounts**. It looks like a triangle.



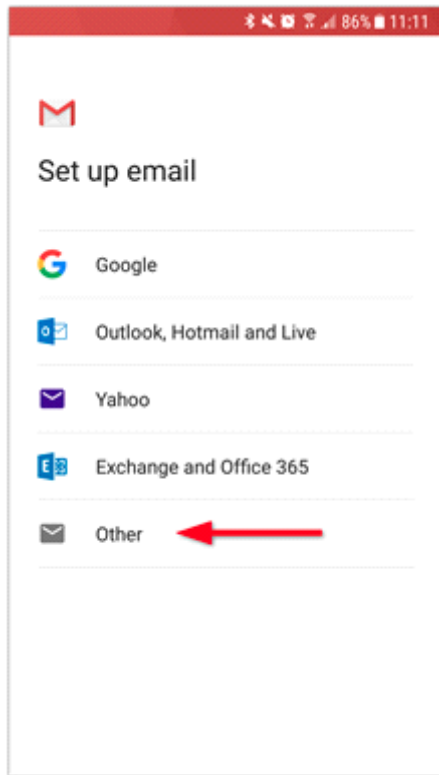
Step 4 - Click Add account

Click **Add account** to start setup.



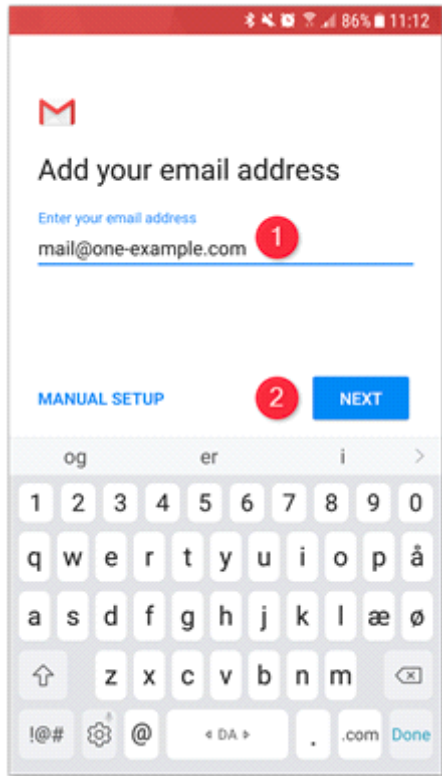
Step 5 - Click Other

Select **Other** as the account you want to set up.



Step 6 - Enter your email address

- Type in the email address you want to set up.
- Click **Next**



IMAP protocol :

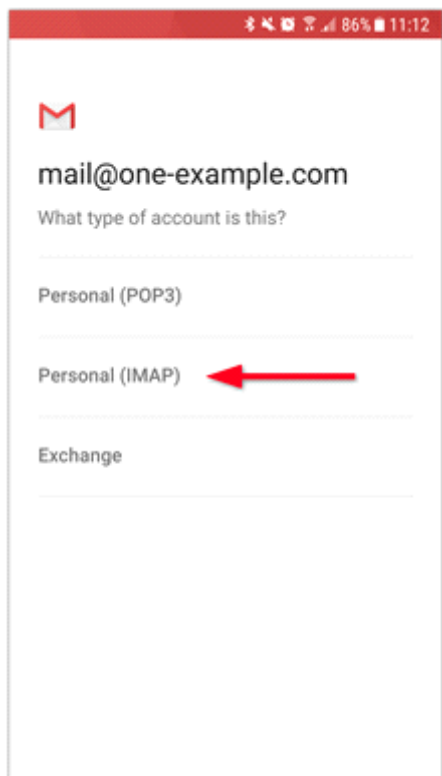
(Note: These settings are useful when mails are being accessed from multiple devices.)

POP3 protocol:

(Note: Mails configured as POP3 will be downloaded to the device and should not be used while accessing mails through multiple devices.)


Step 7 - Select IMAP

Select IMAP as the account type.



Step 8 - Enter your password

- Type in your email **password**, the one you use to log in to Webmail.
- Click **Next**.

- Type in **i.mail25.info** as the incoming server.

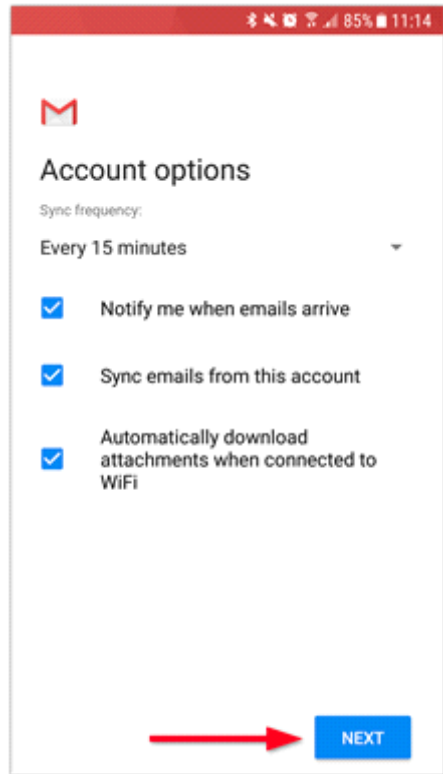
Step 10 - Enter **s.mail25.info** for outgoing server

- Type in **s.mail25.info** the outgoing server.
- Click **Next**.


Step 11 - Select account options
